 "With inflation easing and a favourable monsoon forecast, the outlook for consumption remains optimistic," he added.
 Sales volumes for the number of units sold) grew 8.4% from a year earlier in the rural markets, compared with 4.6% in cities, the data showed. The gap between urban and villages has narrowed as growth in urban markets started improving. In the previous quarter, rural areas rose 8.4% by volume, compared with 2.6% increase in urban sales. This pickup in urban demand bodes well for the industry, as a slowdown in India's cities has been a major drag on overall growth, even as rural demand has been holding up. A cut in income tax rates and reduction in interest rates are expected

to leave more disposable income with consumers, especially in cities, and some of this money is expected to be spent on packaged consumer goods, boosting demand. Goldman Sachs predicts urban demand to improve, albeit slightly, in the coming quarter. "Rural recovery has been robust, driven by a strong winter harvest, good sowing, subdued food inflation and increased welfare spending at the state level," Goldman wrote in a report earlier this week. "Urban consumption trends are mixed, impacted by idiosyncratic events and softer discretionary

spending, but we expect them to slightly improve as the lagged impact of rate cuts eases financial conditions later in the year," it said.
FAVOURABLE MONSOON, INCOME TAX CUT
 Makers of soap, tea, snacks and edible oils have noted in their June quarter earnings that favourable monsoons, income tax cuts and easing inflation are bringing about gradual recovery. "The resurgence (in sales) is primarily driven by smaller towns, while metropolitan areas continue to experience a decline in consumption owing to channel shift," it said. "Additionally, the rapid rise of small manufacturers outpacing overall industry growth highlights dynamics and

intensifying competition," Nielsen's Pant said.
 The research firm, however, cautioned that sustaining this growth momentum would require deeper channel engagement and sharper value-led propositions. "The industry is entering a phase where agility and consumer-centric innovation will be critical to future success. Additionally, the rapid rise of small manufacturers outpacing overall industry growth highlights shifting market dynamics and intensifying competition," Nielsen's Pant said.
